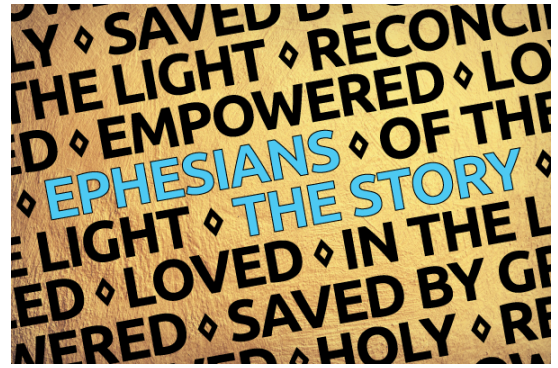


Ephesians:

- What does unity mean to you?
- What does the phrase, "In essentials, unity; in non-essentials, liberty; and in all things, love" mean to you?
