- Read Deuteronomy 4:25-31.
- This passage starts with talking about the Israelites becoming corrupt after they've been in the Promised Land for a long time. How can this warning apply to our lives?
- What kind of impact have you seen when you or someone you know has stopped seeking something worldly and returned to seeking God?
- Read Isaiah 55:1-7.
- This passage speaks of a free invitation. Do you think an offer being free makes it more difficult to accept? Why or why not?
- Verse 6 says, "Seek the Lord while he may be found." Do you think this implies that there is only a specific window of time that we can seek God? Why or why not?
- Do you struggle more with accepting God's free pardon for yourself or seeing others accept the free pardon? Why?
- Read Matthew 6:31-33.
- Why do you think we seek after and worry about things like clothing and food?
- While seeking God, have you ever not had your basic needs met?
- I think we can all agree that each day has enough trouble of its own, so why do we constantly worry about tomorrow?
