- Between heart and soul (seek), mind (study), and strength (serve), which areas do you feel you are doing the best and worst in? What do you think helps you succeed in your best and struggle in your worst?
- What does it mean to love your neighbor as yourself?
- Does the way you live reflect the statement "[these commandments are] more important than all burnt offerings and sacrifices?" Why or why not?
- George challenged us to "think, go, and do." What prevents you from each of these steps?
