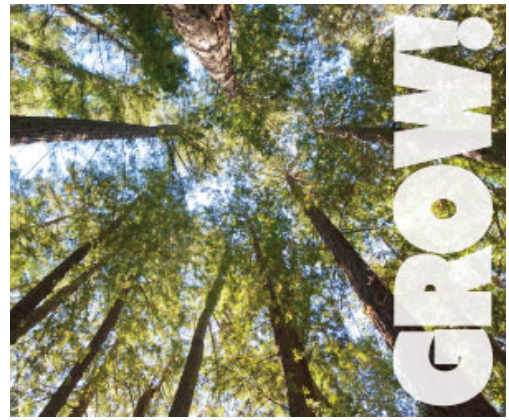

- Read Mark 12:18-27.
- What does it mean that God is the God of the living, not the dead?
- The Sadducees ask a question about Heaven based on our understanding of earthly things. What are some of the things you assume about Heaven that are based on how life is on earth?
- Read Ecclesiastes 4:1-3.
- How can the author of Ecclesiastes come to the conclusion that things are best for those who have not yet been created?
- Read 1 Peter 1:3-6.
- What does having a living hope mean to you?
- What does it mean to you to have an eternal inheritance that will never spoil or fade?
- Read 1 Corinthians 15:13-19.
- If Christ was not raised, why would we be more deserving of pity than everyone else?
- If our faith depends on Christ being raised from the dead, how does that make you feel about the afterlife and what awaits us at death?
- Read Romans 6:3-6 and 8:10-11 and Revelation 21:1, 5.
- What hope do these passages give you?
- Do you currently live in a way that reflects that hope? Why or why not?

Prayer: Pray that we live knowing that we have an inheritance waiting in Heaven and Christ's sacrifice is the only way to gain it. Pray that you share the hope that that knowledge gives you.
