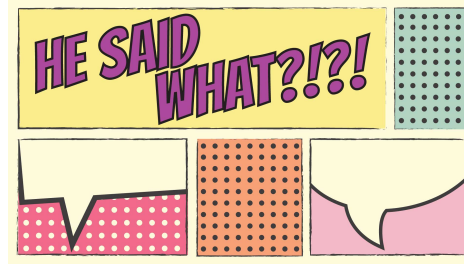


He Said What?!

- What are some ways to do better at seeing people as fellow children of God, as opposed to having an "us vs. them" mentality?
