Read: Romans 3:23, 6:23, 8:1, 38-39, and 12:1-2.

- Who or what do you surround yourself with when you need some encouragement or to escape the difficulties around us?
- How are you shaping the people around you, especially during this time of quarantine?
- What does it mean to you be a living sacrifice, as mentioned in Romans 12:1?
