- Read 2 Corinthians 5:16-21.
- When we are born again through baptism, the Greek phrases it in such a way as to say we are brought into being again. It's not like we take a bath, or put on new clothes, or even just change our name. The old us ceases to exist and something entirely new is created. If baptized, do you feel like you are a new creation? Why or why not? What would help increase or create that feeling?
- What does reconciliation mean to you? What is involved in reconciliation?
- What does it mean to you to be an ambassador for God?
- How can you spread the message of reconciliation to your neighbors?
- What are some of the areas you do well in as God's ambassador? What areas do you need to do some work in?
- What does it mean to you to become the righteousness of God?
