- When you pray, how often is it that thankfulness is a part of your prayers?
- How does it make you feel when you do something for someone and they thank you for it versus when they do not?
- What can we do to make praising God a natural piece of our daily lives?
- As we conclude this study, what was the biggest take away for you from the whole series?
