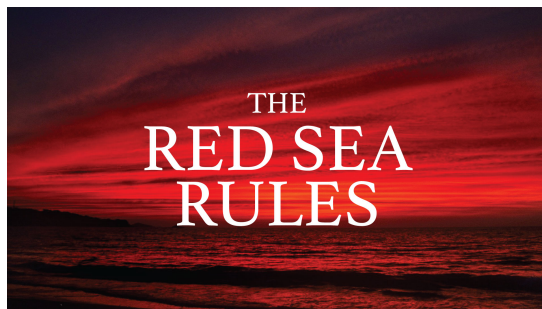


Red Sea Rules
