- Read John 20:30-31 and keep it in mind.
- Have you ever been at a wedding or other social event where supplies have run out? How was the situation handled?
- Read John 2:1-12.
- What stands out to you in this passage?
- How are miracles and signs different in your mind?
- Why do you think that Jesus performed this sign even though it wasn't yet his time?
- What do you think is the significance of Jesus transforming water that is contained in jars used for ceremonial washing?
- What connection do you see between Jesus's wine being superior to the old wine and Jesus coming to earth?
- Do you struggle with praying for God to help with the little things in your life? Why or why not? Does this passage impact that struggle? Why or why not?
- The Eastern Church has long celebrated the Festival of Epiphany on January 6th, remembering on that day the birth of Jesus, the arrival of the magi, Jesus's baptism, and the miracle at Cana. Why do you think the miracle at Cana is remembered among those other events?
- Read Amos 9:13-15.
- How do you think this passage connects with both of the John passages read above?
- Jesus's signs reveal his glory, which points to God. Do your actions also point towards God's glory? How can we live in a way that points towards God?
