

- What can you do to be a witness to others, even in the face of severe hardship?

## Read Acts 16:30-34

- The Philippian jailer and his entire family found what they were searching for, and came to faith in Jesus that night.
  - $\circ$  In what ways do you see people searching for hope/salvation/meaning?
  - In what ways does Jesus satisfy all of those things, and more?

**Prayer:** Pray that God will enable the members of your group to boldly proclaim Christ by the way they act and speak – just as Paul and Silas did.
